Agored Cymru uses innovative and flexible approaches to developing qualifications to meet skills needs in Wales. It provides learners with the opportunity to develop a wide variety of knowledge and skills that relates to the areas such as Citizenship, Careers and PSHE.

Agored Cymru qualifications are widely recognised, valued and respected by employers. This means that Agored Cymru accredited learners are in a strong position to find a job or progress in their careers.

All students in our current Year 10 will study towards completing an **Agored Cymru qualification in Personal and Social Education** during the PSHE programme in Year 10 and 11. Year 11 are working towards a different qualification because of time lost to locThe personal and social education (PSE) qualification supports key educational policy areas of the Welsh Government including the Personal and Social Education Framework for 7 to 19-year-olds in Wales.

- The qualifications support learners to increase their skills and knowledge to improve their personal and social development and emotional health and wellbeing. This ensures that young people become equipped and confident individuals so that they can effectively and successfully live in a fast changing society and fulfil their ambitions.
- Students will complete a variety of units over 2 years, including units on resilience, study skills, revision skills and personal money management to name a few. Details of the work covered and all resources can be found on our website and Google Classroom.

Some students may also study towards an additional qualification. Agored Cymru Level 2 Extended Certificate in Work Related Education allows students to develop knowledge and skills that are directly linked to the World of Work. Students will complete a variety of units over 2 years. 18 credits are required to pass the course. Each unit is worth 1 to 3 credits
